CFO MANDATORY PRE-DEPARTURE SEMINARS

- Pre-departure Orientation Seminar (PDOS)
 - required for Filipinos 20-59 years old
- Peer Counseling Program (PCP)
 - required for Filipinos 13-19 years old
- Guidance and Counseling Program (GCP)
 - required for Filipino spouses and other partners of foreign nationals

PRE-DEPARTURE ORIENTATION SEMINAR (PDOS)



- Country-specific seminars daily
- Japan seminars are conducted every Tuesday - online Wednesday to Friday - in person
- Topics discussed include travel regulations, basic immigration procedures, cultural differences, settlement concerns, employment and social security concerns, rights and obligations of Filipino migrants, and support network.







PEER COUNSELING PROGRAM (PCP)

- For 13 to 19 years old
- Conducted daily for youth emigrants bound for various countries
- Discussions on issues of young migrants such as anxiety, language barrier, rejection, discrimination, separation, bullying, stress, culture shock, among others







GUIDANCE AND COUNSELING PROGRAM (GCP)

- For Filipino spouses and other partners of foreign nationals
- Conducted daily for marriage migrants bound for various countries
- Includes information relative to cultural differences, settlement concerns, rights and obligations, available support and welfare services in other countries
- Serve as an intervention program for marriage migrants who may be potential victims of trafficking in the guise of intermarriage
